New Morning School is the only Preschool - 8th Grade Parent Cooperative School in Michigan. As part of our mission, we strive to engage parents in the school environment in a variety of ways. Our program is designed on this partnership and students flourish because of it. We know that parental involvement is a key indicator to school success, which is why we greatly value parent support. Our program allows families with a variety of circumstances to engage in our community.

Cooperative Participation Program - Base Pricing

By joining our school program, we expect all families to participate at a minimum engagement level in our parent cooperative program. Cooperative Participation pricing includes the following contractual obligations:

At least one adult family member to participate in the following:

- Attend Evening Community Meetings 5 total
 - Aug: Welcome Back Picnic
 - Sept: Community Eat & Meet Program Night
 - Oct: Community Eat & Meet Fundraiser Kick-Off & Parent Learning
 - Jan or Feb: Community Eat & Meet School Updates & Parent Learning
 - o Apr: Community Eat & Meet Community Connection
- Attend Parent-Teacher Conferences on scheduled days (see school calendar)
- New Families Attend NMS Orientation
- New Families Attend NMS History & Philosophy (Formerly Pizza & Piaget Night)
- Maintenance Workday 4 hours (1 shift of 4 hours)
- Festival Shifts 4 hours total (1 shift of 4 hours or 2 shifts of 2 hours)

Families unable to participate in the Cooperative Participation Program, may consider paying an annual fee of \$2500 to opt-out of the program.

Tuition Discounts

Co-op Role Discounts

Beyond the base participation in our parent cooperative program, families may opt to engage in our school community by applying for a Co-op Assignment. There are a number of Co-op Assignments that support our school program. Each role is designed to help the school continue it's mission. Our co-op participation allows us to deliver an instructional program with a high level of support in each classroom. Roles are also designed to support the school in ways which offset costs and allows the school to keep most of it's operating budget pointed towards instruction.

Guidelines:

Co-op discounts are assigned as a value based on the Co-op Assignment type. (See table below)

- Co-op Assignments are limited to the needs of the program.
- Co-op discounts are applied to the first/oldest child enrolled.
- Families with 1 child may accept 2 co-op roles.
- Families with 2 or more children may accept 3 co-op roles.
- Only 1 Sr. Leadership position can be accepted per adult.
- Families needing to reduce tuition obligations, having maximized their Co-op Assignments may apply for Financial Aid/Scholarship.

Discretionary terms:

- Should co-op assignments go unfulfilled, at the discretion of the Head of School, additional roles may be assigned per family.
- The Head of School has the right to increase or decrease Co-op Assignments based on the needs of the school program from year to year.

Eligibility:

- All families are encouraged and eligible to apply for Co-op Assignments.
- Co-op Assignments may require a demonstration of skills, or willingness to attend training for that the role.
 - o For example, if participating as a classroom aide, prior experience in working with school age children may be required, or a willingness to attend training.
- Parents must be in their second year or later of participating in the Cooperative Parent Program to participate in a Jr. or Sr. Leader position.

Other Discounts:

As the Co-op Assignments are applied to the first or oldest child enrolled, Sibling Discounts are applied to those children who are enrolled full time. (part-time preschool not eligible)

- 2nd child \$2500
- 3rd or more children \$3500

Scholarship/Financial Aid

New Morning School offers financial assistance to those families eligible based on a completed application. Families applying for financial assistance must first maximize co-op discount opportunities. Please inquire with our Director of Admissions & Operations. Indicate interest in participating in a co-op role through the intent to return form. Once indicated, you will set up a meeting with Head of School, Pauline Nagle, to discuss your skill set and interest in varying roles.

Co-op Roles and Values

After all interested families have met with the Head of School, roles will be offered and filled. If you choose not to accept a position, another role may or may not be offered, dependent on availability. New Morning School strives to match parent interest and skills for the benefit of the program overall.

Before & After Care - Kids' Club 2025-2026

Kids' Club (before and after care) is offered at New Morning School as a convenience to our families that need child care beyond school hours. We run our before and after care programs with our school aides and maintain low adult: child ratios for a good experience.

Eligibility: All students are eligible to attend Kids' Club.

Preschool Full-Time Care (Attends 5 Full Days per week) is included in tuition.

AM Only Preschool students are eligible for AM Care only, at an extra cost. Full Day, Part-Time students are eligible for AM & PM Care, at an extra cost. .

Hours:

Before Care Hours: 7:00am-8:50*am (*8:10 for MS/8:25 for Prim & Elem/8:50 for PreK)

After Care Hours: 3:15pm-6:00pm (snack provided)

Specified Non-School Day Care: AM session 7am-12:30pm OR Full Day session

7am-6pm (see School Calendar)

Registration: There is no additional registration fee. Registration is included with your Enrollment. All NMS families must register for at least Drop-In Care.

You must separately enroll in Kids' Club, per Child Care Licensing rules, at least 1 week in advance of your child's start date. A link for registration is provided with enrollment materials.

Fee Options: There are two ways to opt-in to Kids' Club, Contracted or Drop-In Care.

Contracted Care - Advanced

- Fixed Number of Days each week
- Choose number of days of care per week, in advance, when registering.
- Pay in full in advance OR pay a fixed monthly fee based on your plan.
- Minimum 2 days per week

AM Only: \$10 per day PM Only: \$17 per day AM & PM: \$23 per day

Non-School Full Days: \$23 AM or \$46 FULL Day

*10% Discount for siblings

Drop-In Care

Flexible scheduling. No minimum number of days required.

Pay as you go, invoiced at the end of the month.

AM Only: \$15 per day PM Only: \$25 per day

Non-School Full Days: \$40 AM or \$80 FULL day

(must sign up 1 week in advance, to allow for staffing)

Payment Plan Options

New Morning School offers the following payment options:

Pay In Full - 4% Discount

- Full tuition payment by May 15, 2025. Payment should be made directly to New Morning School. Payment will be entitled to a prepayment discount of 4%. These payment options may be made by check, or if paying by ACH or credit card, fees will apply.
- Full tuition payment in 2 payments (for 2 or more children) 50% payment by May 15th and remainder by August 15th. Payment should be made directly to New Morning School. Payment will be entitled to a prepayment discount of 4%. These payment options may be made by check, or if paying by ACH or credit card, fees will apply.

Monthly Payment Plan

Monthly payments by paying via monthly invoices through the Snowman DaySchool Family Portal only. Checks are not accepted. Invoices are due at the beginning of each month, or within 10 days of receipt. Monthly payments begin in May and end in March, for 11 payments, or the number of months left in the cycle when enrolled.

Invoices not paid within 10 days of the invoice may incur a late fee of \$30. Credit card/ACH fees will apply to monthly payments.

Credit Card Fees

A 3% charge is added to your invoice when paying by credit card.

ACH Fees

A \$4 per transaction fee is added to each invoice
