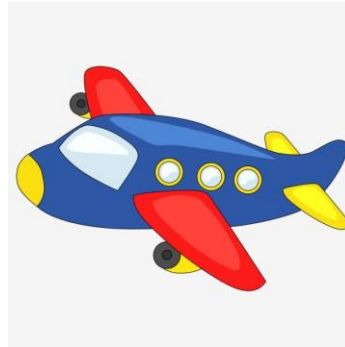
Young children and their grown-ups are invited to frolic this Fall at New Morning School.
